The production of Shea Butter has a long tradition in Africa: the women of the village communities collect and process the nuts by hand. Conventional roasting processes produce a lot of smoke, which is harmful to health and the environment.

Four innovative enclosed shear oasters and a tricycle for fast and safe transportation: This is the investment by Henry Lamotte Oils in cooperation with the Savannah Fruits Company for the Jakpahi cooperative in Ghana to support the women in their daily work. Thanks to the new roasters, they benefit from less smoke and save time in the manufacturing process. The new process saves 80 percent of CO₂ emissions and 90 percent of firewood.
